

Cinema

The four cinema halls are equipped with digital projectors and 3D technology. If you want to see a blockbuster in 3D, please check the program for films that are specially marked. A total of 414 people can be accommodated in the cinema halls.





The films start daily at 5:30 pm and 8:00 pm. Additionally, movies are shown at 10:30 pm on weekends and before holidays. On Fridays through Sundays, you can also watch a movie at 3:00 pm. During the Bavarian school holidays, current films start at 3:00 pm, 5:30 pm, and 8:00 pm, and on Fridays, Saturdays, and holidays, they start at 10:30 pm.

Tickets can be purchased half an hour before the first screening. The box office is then open continuously until the end of the film.

Guest card

In the Schliersee region, every host collects a tourist tax on behalf of the municipality. This contribution serves, among other things, to maintain the community's spa facilities. The amount is calculated based on the number of overnight stays. The guest registration must be made by the guest or his host within the first 24 hours of arrival.



For adults over 18 years of age, the tourist tax is 2.00 euros per overnight stay, and for children over six years old, it is 1.00 euro per overnight stay. Guests who stay in the Schliersee region as part of a conference, seminar, or business trip pay 1.00 euro.

Children up to the age of 6 and severely disabled people with the "aG," "BI," and "H" notes on their disability ID card, as well as all accompanying persons listed therein, are exempt from the tourist tax.

You will receive the guest card upon arrival at your accommodation. The guest card includes, among other things, free use of all RVO buses in the Miesbach district, free use of the Wendelstein Ring Line during the summer months, and free or discounted admission to museums, swimming pools, and other facilities or events in Schliersee, Fischbachau, and Bayrischzell.

You can scan the QR code provided for all current services of the Schliersee guest card.



Markus- Wasmeier Open Air Museum

The Markus Wasmeier Open-Air Museum Schliersee was opened in May 2007 and presents visitors with an entire farm village. The museum was initiated by double Olympic champion and world champion Markus Wasmeier. The aim of the exhibition is to preserve the cultural heritage of the region and to maintain it for future generations..



Markus Wasmeier, the skiing legend, was not only one of the best ski racers in Germany. He achieved his greatest successes in giant slalom and won the corresponding world championship title in 1985.

At the 1994 Winter Olympics in Lillehammer, Norway, he won a gold medal in the super-G and giant slalom. He was also named Athlete of the Year, becoming the first male skier to receive this honor in the same year. After the opening of the Markus Wasmeier Open Air Museum in Schliersee, he was awarded the Bavarian Sports Prize in the category of "High Performance Athlete Plus" and the Bavarian Order of Merit. Due to his deep connection to his home, his hometown of Schliersee named him an honorary citizen.



The Markus Wasmeier Open-Air Museum Schliersee is located in Fischhausen-Neuhaus, directly on the southern shore of Lake Schliersee. Here, on approximately 60,000 square meters, ten historic buildings with several farmsteads from the Oberland show how people lived and worked in past centuries. Stone by stone, the individual components of the houses were transported to Neuhaus and rebuilt or lovingly restored there.

Almost the entire grounds of the Markus Wasmeier Open-Air Museum Schliersee are accessible without barriers, and a disabled-friendly toilet can be found in the tavern.

Most of the buildings can be visited with the help of an accompanying person. If you need a wheelchair, a free one is available at any time.



Dog owners and their leashed pets are welcome at all times. There are special leash hooks in the restored courtyards and buildings, as pets are not allowed inside. Free waste disposal bags are provided at the museum entrance for cleaning up after pets.

On the museum's meadows, there are old domestic animal breeds, some of which are even endangered, such as chickens, geese, cows, pigs, and mountain sheep. Old cultivated plants, alpine herbs, and various types of vegetables are also grown in the meadows and farm gardens.



All visitors can order various authentic Bavarian specialties in the museum's own restaurant and sunny beer garden and enjoy the museum's own beer, brewed in the on-site brewery according to a recipe that dates back more than 300 years. Additionally, various cultural events, craft markets, music days, and a Christmas market are regularly held at the Markus Wasmeier Freilichtmuseum Schliersee.

Monte Mare Vitaltherme

Even on rainy days, there are so many things to do in the Schliersee region that you and your family can enjoy. Treat yourself to a day of relaxation at the monte mare Vitaltherme and Sauna Schliersee.



The 25-meter swimming pool is heated to 30°C and you can relax on a massage or bubble bed in the pool. Meanwhile, your children can enjoy themselves in the spacious children's area. The water there is heated to 34°C and interactive water toys are available for them to play with. The 50-meter "Black Hole" slide with light and sound effects provides a lot of fun and excitement for both big and small water rats.





The outdoor brine pool with bubble cave has a temperature of 32°C and the whirlpool is heated to 35°C.

After your swim, in bad weather you can relax indoors on the spacious sun loungers or on the warm beds. Adults can use the time at the monte mare Vitaltherme to catch some sun in the solarium and relax for a few minutes in the textile steam bath.







In our "Britschl-Stub'n" (a separate solid wood block house/ sauna house), you will find almost all modern and classic forms of relaxation.





Ski Resorts

Spitzingsee

Slopes: 20 km



Where numerous hiking trails lead into the impressive Alpine landscape in summer, one of the most popular ski resorts in Germany can be found in winter. Around the picturesque Spitzingsee lake is one of the most beautiful leisure regions in Bavaria. The high valley at 1,085 meters impresses nature lovers in both summer and winter. Snowmaking systems ensure snow reliability, high-performance ski lifts ensure short waiting times at the lifts. Around the Stümpfling, mainly medium-difficulty slopes await you at 1,100 to 1,700 meters, which are particularly popular with families and beginners.

Experts will find their Eldorado on the Roßkopf, where the short but crisp Roßkopf descent or the long demanding Grünsee descent awaits. With the new construction of the Roßkopf chairlift five years ago, the Grünsee descent, which stretches from the Roßkopf summit at 1,543 meters as a black challenge down to the Valepp and thus overcomes more than 500 meters in altitude, has experienced a new upswing and delights demanding winter sports enthusiasts..

GREAT FOR KIDS

Especially for the little ones, there are also two kids parks in the Spitzingsee-Tegernsee ski area. With carpet and rope lifts, obstacle courses, and child-friendly, flat practice slopes, learning to ski is a lot of fun there. In the two children's areas, it's all about learning, practicing, and above all: having fun..

Please note that both kids parks are operated by the mentioned ski schools. For insurance reasons, only children registered with the ski schools can use the children's areas.

Every Thursday and Friday from 6:30 pm to 9:30 pm, the lights come on at the Stümpfling descent. Then floodlit skiing on freshly groomed slopes is on the agenda..

Alpen Plus - Season ski pass & multi-day tickets

Season ski passes and multi-day tickets are valid throughout the Alpen Plus network, which includes not only the Spitzingsee-Tegernsee ski area but also the Sudelfeld ski paradise and Brauneck-Wegscheid, and Wallberg (natural toboggan run) ski resorts.

Skiing in a prime location

As one of the largest contiguous ski areas in Germany, Sudelfeld, located just under 15 km away, is known for its variety and family-friendliness. Ambitious winter sports enthusiasts as well as beginners, leisurely skiers, and families with children can all find what they're looking for here.



There are 31 km of ski runs, with 63% of the area covered by artificial snow.

The comfortable, fast, and safe 6-seater Waldkopfbahn takes you to the Middle Sudelfeld, and from there the new, super-modern 8-seater Sudelfeldkopf chairlift takes you to the Upper Sudelfeld. The base station of the Waldkopfbahn also features a modern service center with a ski school office, ski shop, rental and service facilities, as well as modern, heated ski lockers for families and long-term rentals.

Families with children and ski clubs especially appreciate the attractive ski area with flat, child-friendly beginner lifts. The Snuki Kinderland ski



school of Top on Snow competently and entertainingly introduces children of all ages to the art of skiing and prepares them perfectly for their first real descents in an optimally designed facility. The Kinderland at Tannerfeld in Bayrischzell is also a great destination for children, where they can race down the practice slope through arches and over waves in a winter play arena at the edge of the town. Additionally, the Snowtubing track there provides an exciting alternative to skiing.

With the opening of the Actionwelt in the winter of 2015/16, a freestyle and fun paradise for shredders of all ages and skill levels was created. The offer includes not only a professional snow park, which impresses both snowboarders and freeskiers with its numerous obstacles, but also the Freeridecross, which brings the feeling of freeriding to the slopes with its wave tracks and steep curves. The Freeridecross is not only a highlight for snowboarders and freeskiers, but also offers families and children plenty of fun. The freestyle and fun eldorado has long since become the new hotspot in the scene. The Actionwelt offer is supplemented with cool events every new season.

The Martina Loch Ski and Snowboard School team has been active since 1986, teaching snowboarding, skiing, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, and carving to all winter sports enthusiasts. The courses, recognized by DSLV and DSV, start daily at 9:30 am directly at the base station of the Stümpflingbahn. Children as young as three years old can take a course at the ski and snowboard school. In addition to courses for toddlers, beginners, and families, Maria Loch also offers ski guides who accompany groups in exploring the ski resort and help them improve their skills.



To ensure that you can enjoy your skis or snowboard for a long time, the Ski and Board Service team makes sure that the base is well waxed, the edges are properly sharpened, and the bindings are working correctly. Repairs can also be done for you in the workshop.



Ski touring

In the Schliersee region, ski touring enthusiasts can expect a true paradise with varied routes and a unique view of the mountains, Lake Schliersee, or Lake Spitzingsee. The Taubenstein area at Spitzingsee is particularly suitable for ski touring. In winter, the operation of the Spitzingsee Alpine Railways is suspended here.



Before you set off, please note the reports on current snow- and weather conditions. You should also check the avalanche reports again before the tour.

Please don't forget to bring weather-appropriate clothing, ski touring equipment, poles, an avalanche shovel and probe, a GPS device, an Avalanche transceivers, some provisions, a mobile phone, and a first-aid kit.

In an emergency, the safety equipment can help you survive until the rescue services arrive. If you move in unsecured alpine terrain, please note that you act at your own risk and no liability is assumed.

Although nature is covered in snow in winter, plants and animals are still highly vulnerable and must therefore be protected. Therefore, do not go into protected areas and help protect nature.



Slyrs

The SLYRS Bavarian Single Malt Whisky distillery was founded in 1999 by Florian Stetter. During a study trip to Scotland, he had the idea of distilling whisky in Bavaria. He learned the craft of beer brewing at the Hopf brewery in Miesbach, where he made his first "whisky mash



"Slyrs" was originally the name of a monastery at Schliersee. At the same time, this term was an expression for the green-yellow streaks found in the mountain sediments in the region. The whole area was known as "Slyrs". This later developed into the term "Schliersee".

In 2007, the company moved to Neuhaus, and Florian Stetter handed over the management of the company to his brother Anton and the managing director Thomas Flothmann. All whiskies are made with Bavarian grain and alpine spring water. The best-known whiskies of the house include the 3-year-old Single Malt Vintage Whisky by Hans Kemenater and his team, the SLYRS Whisky Liqueur (30% vol.), the barrel finishings of SLYRS whisky, and the limited SLYRS whisky editions, which are aged in up to 50-year-old barrels of the Port wine cellars of the Douro Valley and the most famous bodegas of Jerez. In 2014, the SLYRS Bavarian Single Malt Whisky distillery received the award "Best Single Malt Whisky in Europe" for finishing in the PX barrel.

At the Experience Distillery in Schliersee/Neuhaus, you can learn about the exact production of whisky through a video. Afterwards, you can take a guided tour or explore the distillery on your own. The details of the production process are recorded on small information boards. Afterward, there is a tasting on the balcony of the barrel hall. From there, you have a magnificent view of the Wendelstein massif. In addition to various accessories and Lantenhammer fruit brandies, SLYRS Bavarian Single Malt whiskies are also offered in the in-house shop. The purchase is limited to one bottle per person per visitor.



Swimming

The lake with its clean water offers great swimming conditions in the summer.

For a wonderful swimming experience, there is the Park Strandbad on the eastern shore of the Schliersee with an area of 12,000 square meters: there is a sunbathing lawn with trees providing shade, as well as a beach volleyball court and a three-meter diving tower. Additionally, there is a supervised non-swimmer area, a table tennis table, and a beer garden.

There are also many other swimming areas / beaches around the Schliersee: Two bathing areas are located on the south side, a 5-minute walk from the Fischhausener parking lot. There is also a swimming area near the adventure trail on the west shore of the Schliersee that can only be reached on foot.

For those who prefer a refreshing swim, the Spitzingsee, which is over 300 meters higher than the Schliersee and belongs to the municipality of Schliersee, is recommended. There is a swimming area on the east side directly at the Arabella Alpenhotel.

The Schliersee is not only ideal for swimming and diving, but also windsurfers, kayakers, and stand-up paddlers love to spend time on the lake.



Kajaking:

You can also explore Lake Schliersee from the water with a kayak. At Intersport Berauer, you can find kayaks that can accommodate one to three people. You will be amazed by the magnificent views and the tranquility that you can enjoy during your ride.

Stand-Up-Paddeling (SUP):

It's also fun to move around on a stand-up paddleboard, for example, towards the island and directly gaze at the Brecherspitz and Jägerkamp. You don't need a course for stand-up paddling, but you can rent the appropriate equipment from Intersport Berauer and also receive an introduction to the art of stand-up paddling (SUP). Fischhausen Trail (Schliersee-Fischhausen)

Access at Pfannilift in the Neuhaus-Fischhausen district, 2km

Kirchbichl Trail Schliersee

Easy loop course near Schliersee, towards Althausam.

Classic/Skating, 3.5 km

Valepper Almen Trail (Spitzingsee)

Scenic trail in the Valepp area, very close to the Spitzingsee.

Classic/Skating, 6.5 km - very snow reliable, as it is located in the high valley at over 1000m above sea level.



Hoamatsau Trail (Schliersee)

Nice circular route at the Spitzingsee, access at Kurvenlift.

Classic/Skating, 2 km

Hachlbach Trail (Schliersee-Neuhaus)

Easy circular route at the Rasundastadion in Neuhaus. Classic/Skating, 1 km

There are also very good and long trails in the neighboring communities of Fischbachau and Bayrischzell.



Sledding

Obere Firstalm (Upper Firstalm)

Not only can you spend a great day sledding with your loved ones at Lower Firstalm, but also at Upper Firstalm. The snow hiking trail is about 2.5 kilometers long and is classified as moderate in hiking maps. You need some physical fitness and should be fairly good on foot for the approximately one-hour walk to Upper Firstalm. However, you will be rewarded with a varied tour and a breathtaking view of a beautiful landscape. The highest point of the trail is at an altitude of 1,372 meters and the lowest point is at 1,127 meters.



Walk uphill on the sled run from Spitzingsattel all the way to Upper Firstalm. The sled run is about 3 kilometers long and leads you directly through the forest. Since the trail is only moderately steep, it is no problem for families with children. If you don't have a sled with you, you can rent one at Upper Firstalm. Then the fun in the snow can begin. The sled rental fee is 7 euros.

In addition, it is possible to stop at the mountain inn Upper Firstalm. Besides warm and cold drinks, you can expect soups, regional dishes, hearty snacks, desserts, and snacks in between. Wallberg in Rottach-Egern

The 6.5 km long natural toboggan run at Wallberg is one of the longest and most challenging in Germany. The descent to the valley takes about half an hour. As the run is one of the more demanding ones due to its length and inclination, it is not suitable for small children.



Dogs are not allowed on the toboggan run. The use of airboards for the descent is also not permitted. This is for your own safety as well as that of your dogs. The Wallbergbahn reserves the right to close the toboggan run in unsuitable weather conditions for tobogganing. This can be due to severe icing or large amounts of fresh snow that make the run impassable. If you are planning a toboggan trip to Wallberg, please check for current information on the internet.

The Wendelstein cog railway: Bavaria's first mountain railway

For over 100 years, the cog railway in Brannenburg has been comfortably transporting mountain and hiking enthusiasts into high alpine terrain. The approximately 30-minute ride on the picturesque route alone is an unforgettable experience! Nowadays, modern double railcars take you up to the mountain station at 1,724 m, but lovingly maintained nostalgic trains from 1912 are still in use, for example, during moonlight rides. Those who are in a hurry can use the large cable car in Osterhofen (about 10 minutes by car from our guesthouse) (travel time with the cable car from the parking lot to the mountain station: 7 min.).

Tip: Use the Wendelstein Ring Line. A combined trip including a round trip on the Sudelfeld toll road.

- Hiking trails with access to the cogwheel train and bus ring line, 20-minute summit trail, geology educational trail (guided tours available on request), self-guided Wendelstein cave with interactive information stations (in German and English) (guided tours available on request), Wendelsteinkircherl (a small church), university observatory, exhibition "100 Years of Wendelsteinbahn" (open year-round, free admission).
- In winter, the small but beautiful natural snow ski resort Wendelstein is a popular meeting point for experts and individualists.
- Restaurants: Wendelsteinhaus (1,724 m) with panoramic restaurant, mountain terrace, self-service area and conference room.
- Special events: nostalgic moonlight rides, Sunday brunch, mountain masses, hut party, cave adventure tours, concerts and more.
- Operating hours: Summer 9am to 5pm, winter until 4pm.
